RESPECT THE COMMUNITY OF LIFE



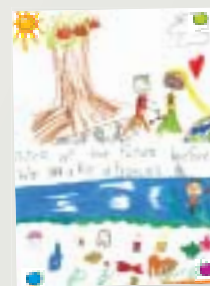
1. Understand the interconnectedness of all living things.

7. Walk lightly on our Earth and use only what we need.

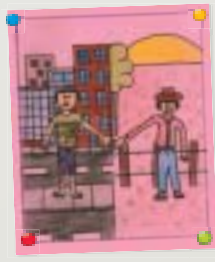


8. Teach others how to keep our Earth clean and healthy.

11. Treat girls and boys fairly.

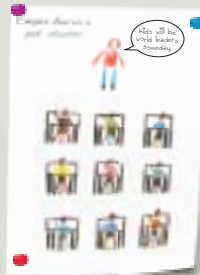


12. Accept all people for who they are, not judging them by their colour, race or gender.
