
# Earth Charter+25 Event

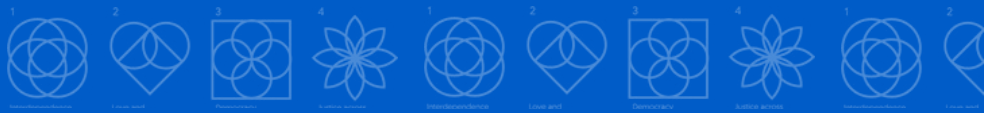
